Fennec Overview

- “Fennec” is the project code name for a version of Firefox designed for non-PC devices, including mobile phones and next-generation mobile Internet devices.
- It’s built upon the same core technology as Firefox, but adds touch-enabled user interface designed for small screens
- Fennec exposes developers to certain device capabilities, such as location, while enabling browser add-ons, extensions, and themes to be created by anyone.
- Today are still early stages of development and optimization, but we’re making Fennec available now to get community feedback and foster participation in the development process.
