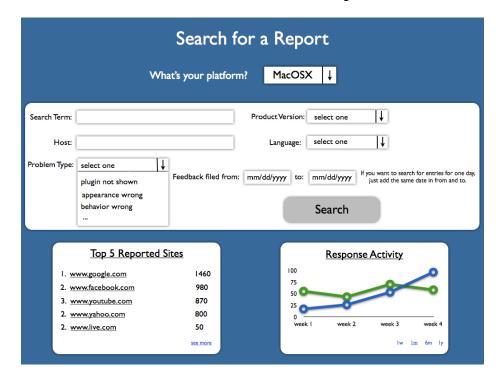

Implementation: Post-Platform-Selection Query Form

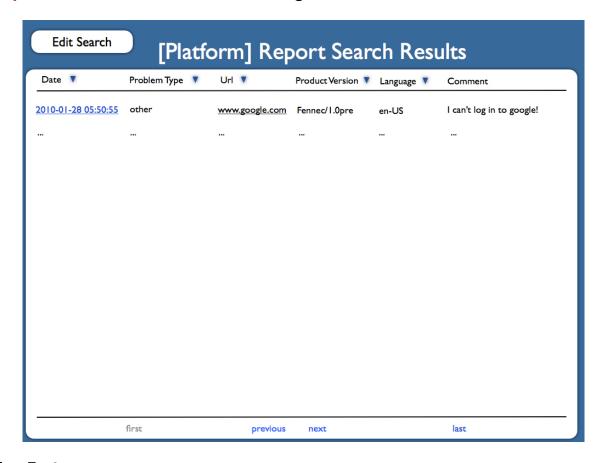
