



Get started on assessing badge applications

Here's what you need to know

Badge assessment tool can be found at assess.chicagosummeroflearning.org

You will need to create a Persona account in order to log in to access the badge applications. Signing up for Persona is easy and if you don't have an account already, you will be prompted to create one onsite.

You will have access to all the badge applications but will have the ability to filter them based on STEAM category.

Learners can only apply for badges for self-paced activities created by DYN.
