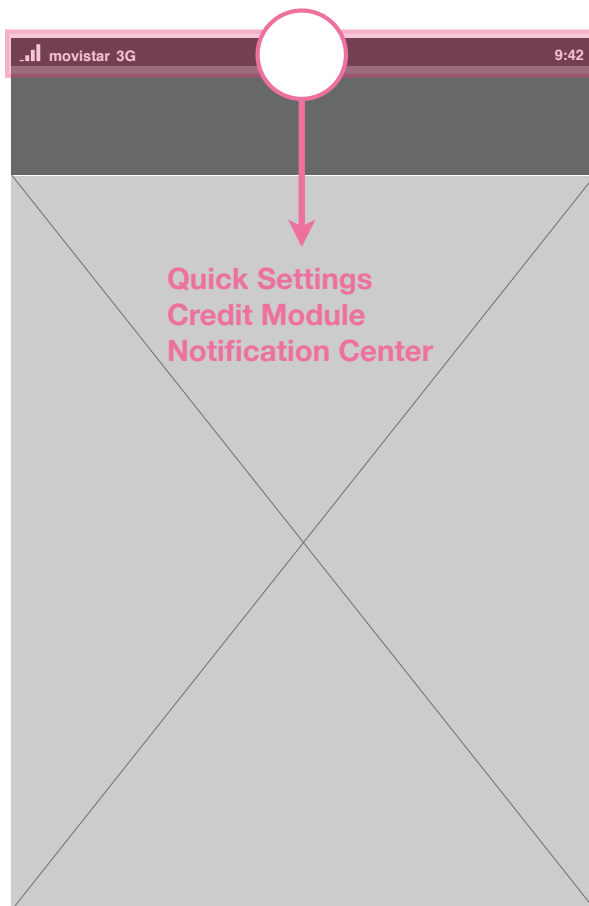

Utility Tray



TEF Single Utility Tray

Telefonica's version unites 3 components together in a single utility tray:

- Quick Settings
- Credit Module
- Notification Center

MOZ Split Utility Tray

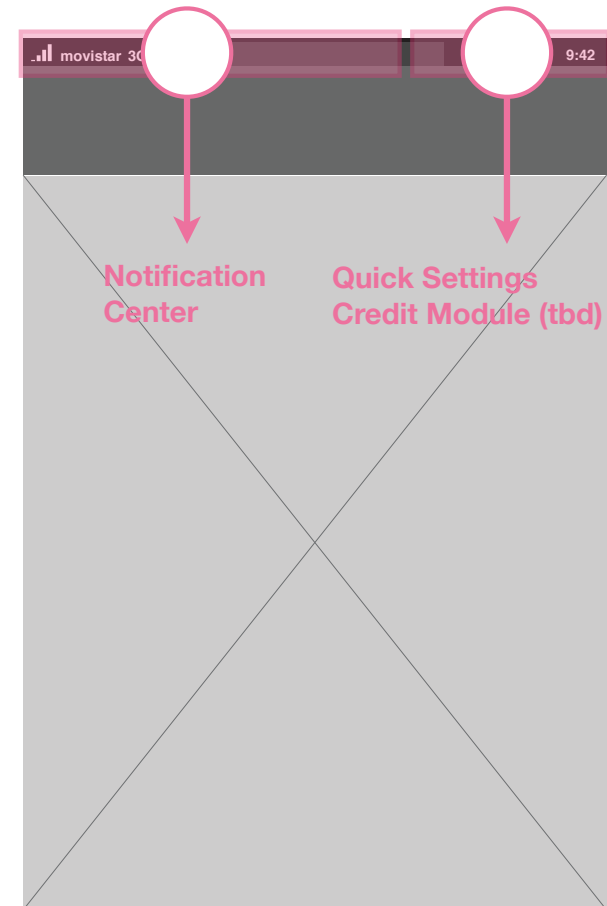
Mozilla's version splits components into two groups, and they are accessed from pulling down a different part of the Status Bar:

Pull Right Side

- Quick Settings
- Credit Module (tbd)

Pull Left Side

- Notification Center



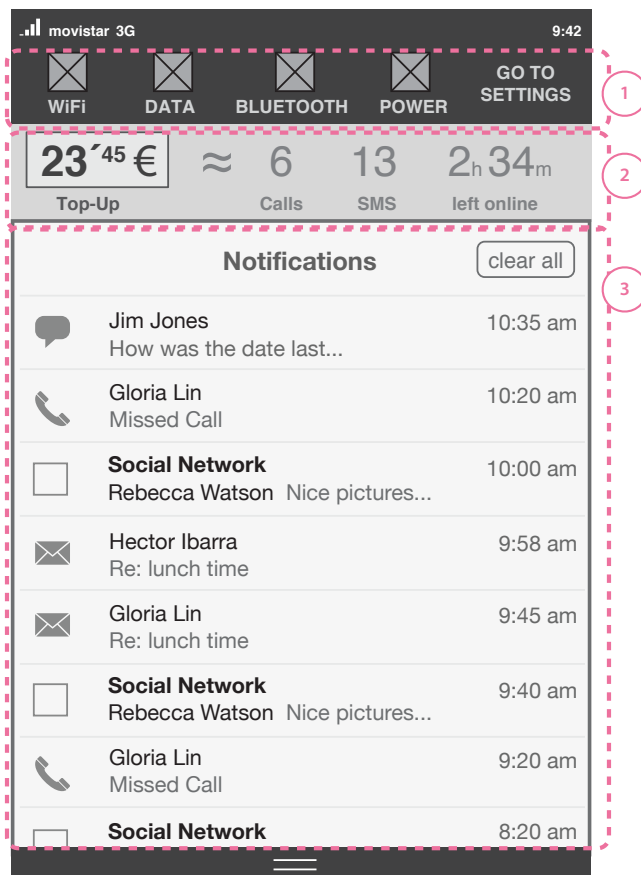
Single Utility Tray

Utility Tray

The Utility Tray is accessed by pulling down on the Status Bar while the user is in the homescreen or within any application.

1 Quick Settings

Quick Settings are an area reserved for settings that get a lot of use.

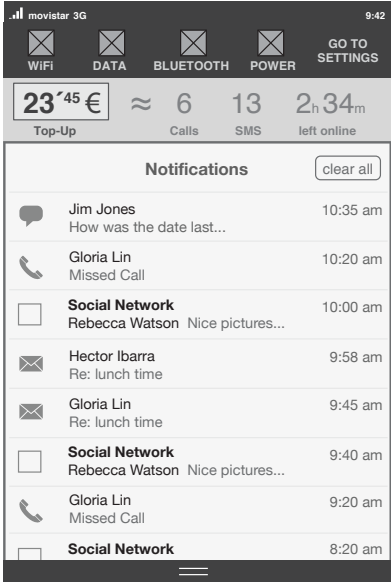
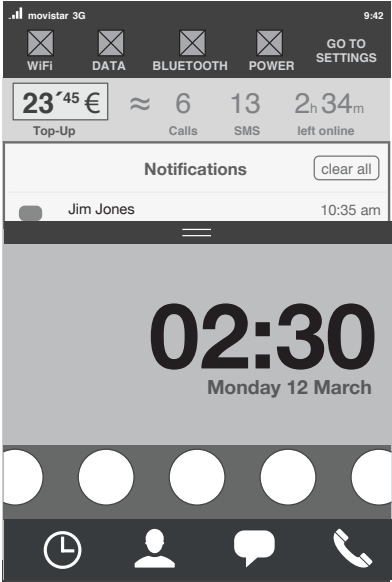
2 Credit Module

The credit module shows credit status in real-time as well as how that credit translates into usage. The top-up button makes it simple to add credit. This version depends on the availability of an API from the operator to provide credit information as well as a free APN for top-up.

3 Notification Center

The Notification Center collects all app related notifications into one place as they come in. Here a user can keep track of all new activity in one place.

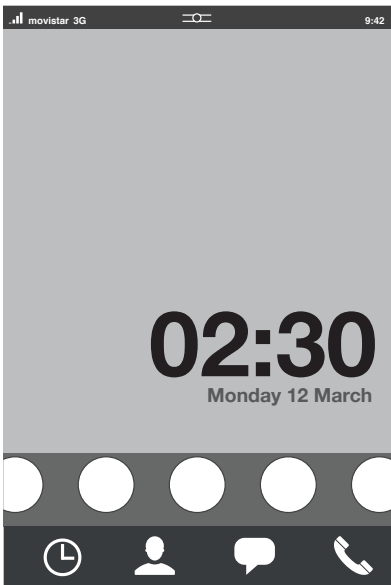
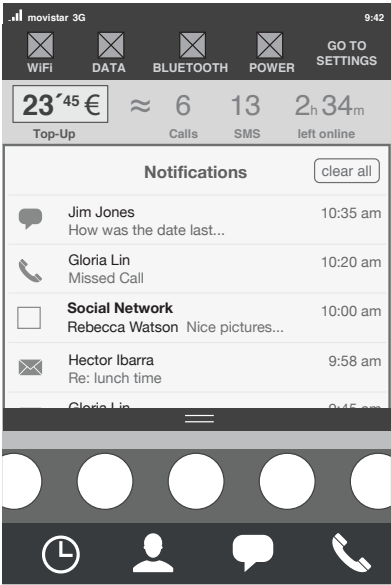
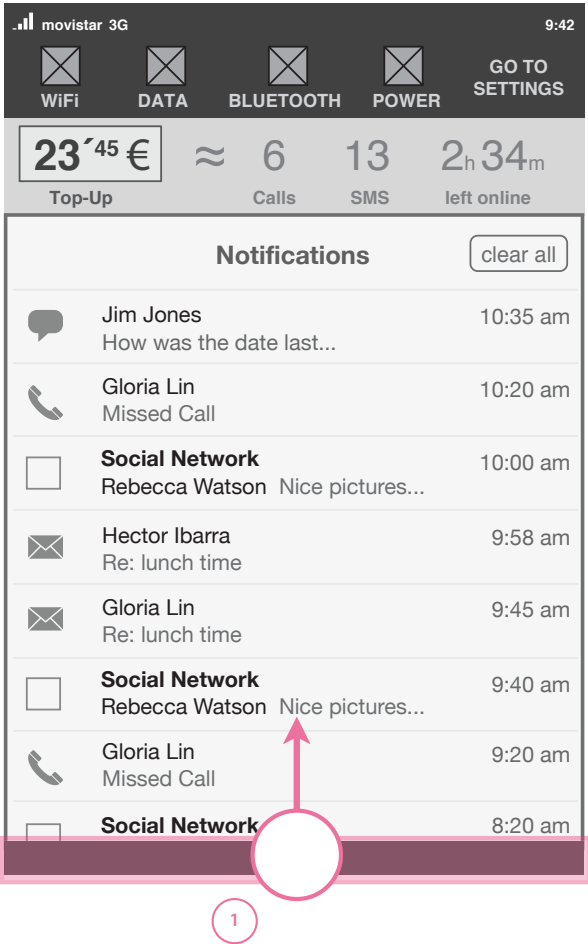
Reveal Behavior Utility Tray



Reveal Gestures

- 1 Swipe **DOWN** on status bar moves grip bar down automatically and reveals notifications underneath.

Close Behavior Utility Tray

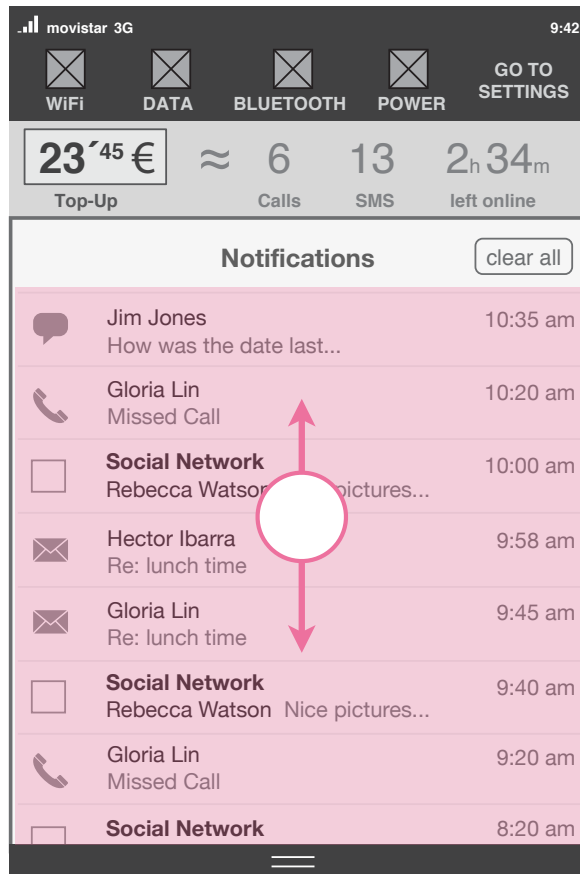


Close Gestures

- 1 Swipe **UP** on grip bar automatically moves grip bar up and closes notifications.

Scroll Behavior Notification Center

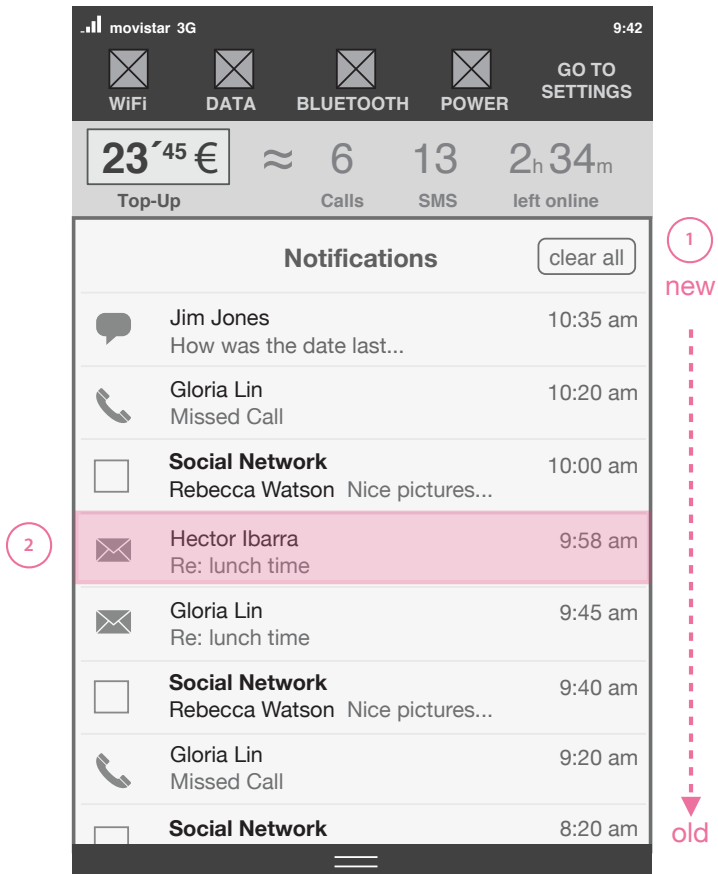


Details

- Scrollable Space**
Area underneath header is scrollable when the number of notifications exceeds the available space.

List Behavior

Details

- 1 Notifications are listed chronologically.
- 2 Tapping on a notification takes you directly to the application and that message view.

List Limit Behavior

There should be a **limit of 30** notifications in the center. Anything beyond 30, and the oldest notifications are cleared automatically when new ones come into the center.

Limit to be confirmed based on prototype testing of this feature.

Read Notifications

When a user views the message or event of the notification in the application, it is deleted automatically from the Notification Center, even if they do not go through the Notification to view it.

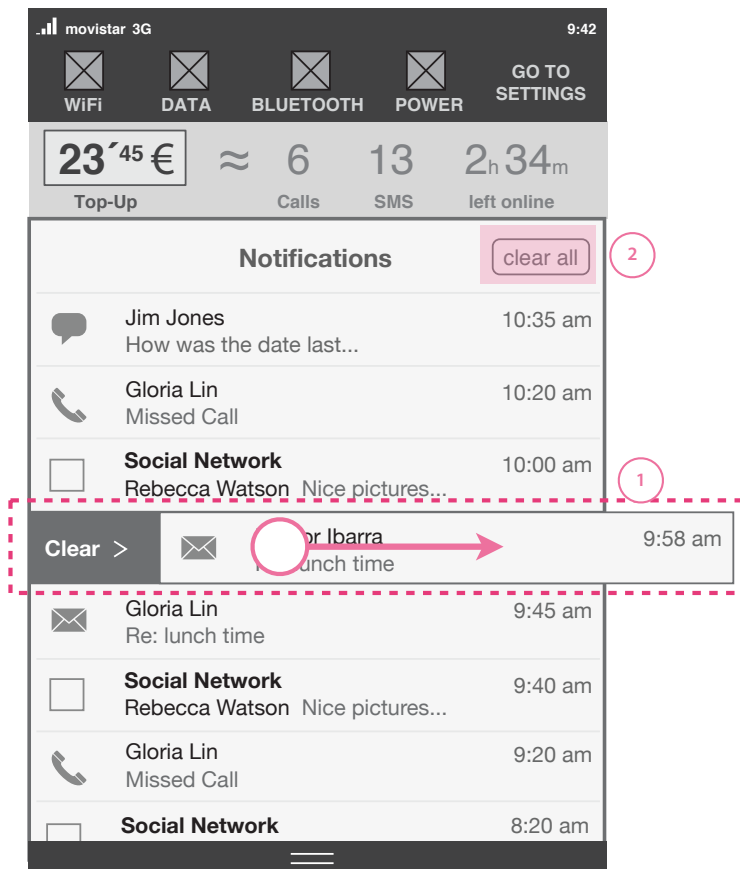
Clearing Notifications from the Center Notification Center

Deleting Notifications

There are two ways of deleting notifications:

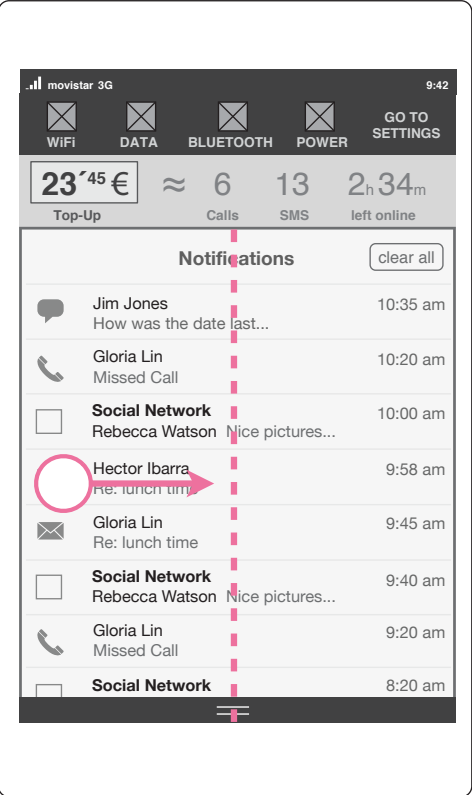
1. Swiping Left to Right on a single notification
2. Clear All button deletes all the notifications from the notification center.

NOTE: Clearing a notification from the center does not delete it from the application, it only deletes the notification from the notification center.

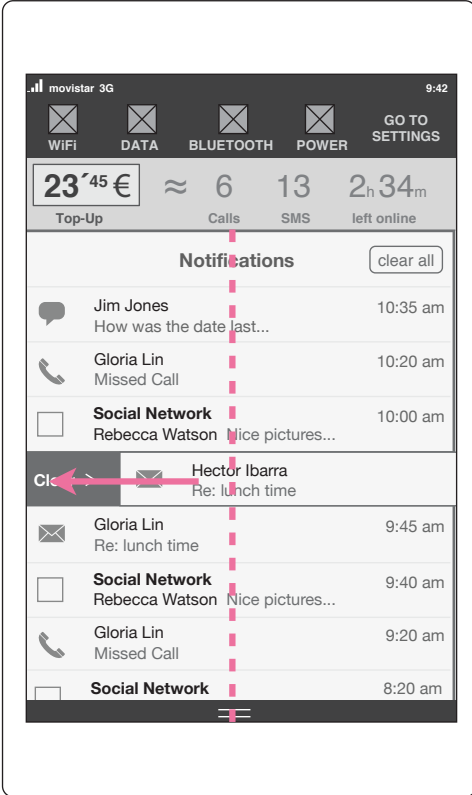


Clearing Notification Gesture

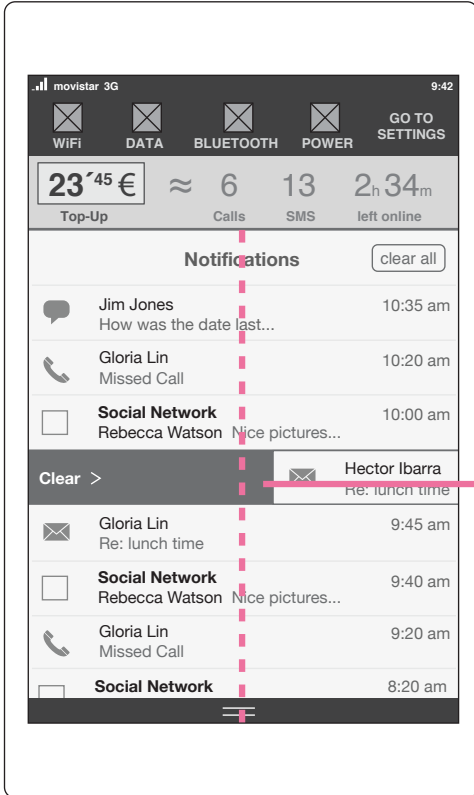
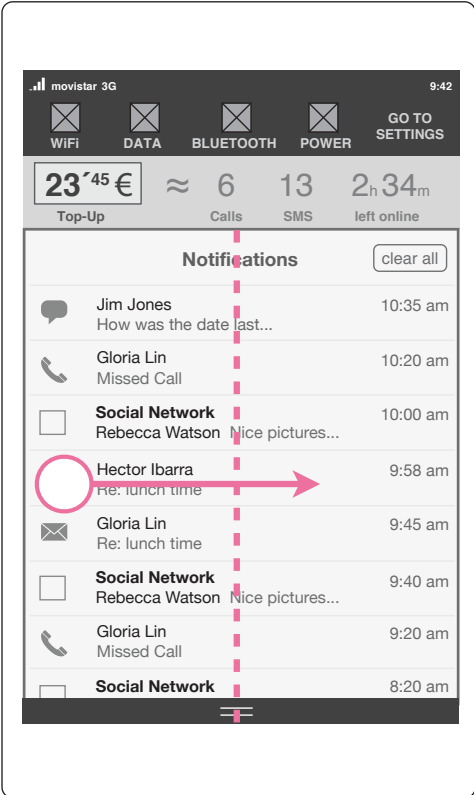
Notification Center



If a user swipes only partially on a notification and not past the half-way point, the notification returns back to it's original position.

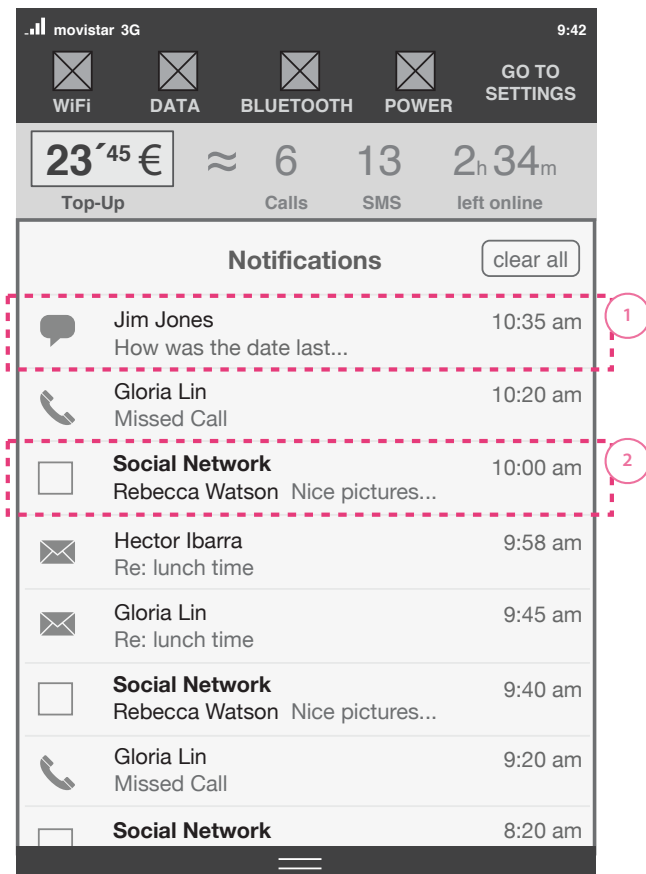


If a user swipes only fully on a notification, past the half-way point, the notification slides all the way out and is deleted.

Notification Center



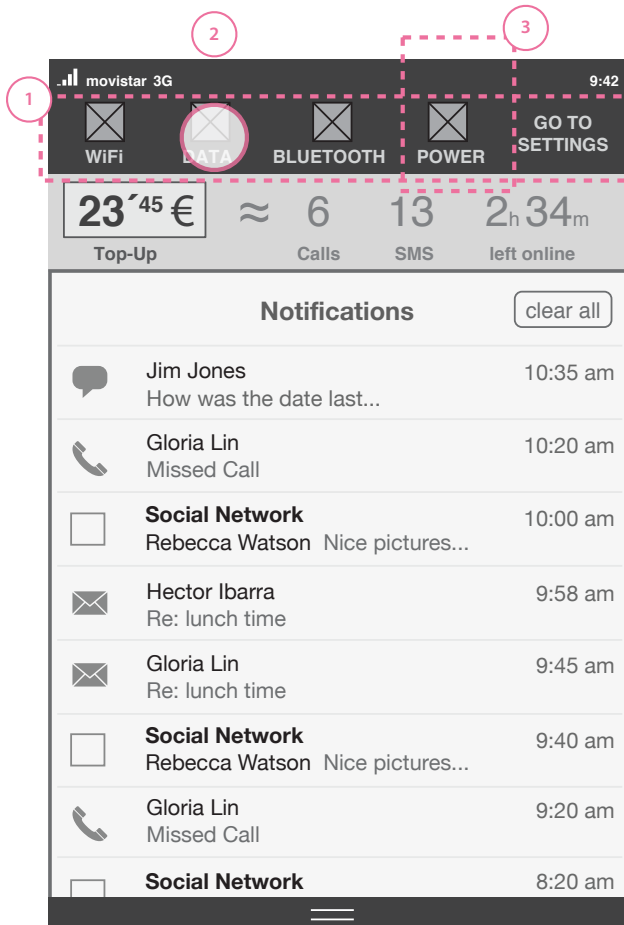
Details

- Core Applications and Trusted Applications**
Two lines for notifications in the Utility Tray.
First line for Sender Name,
Second line for email title, or message preview.
- UnTrusted Applications**
Two lines recommended for notifications in the Utility Tray, but this length is up to each app.
First line must contain app name.

Quick Settings



Details

- 1 Quick Settings are an area reserved for settings that get a lot of use.

WiFi On/Off

Data On/Off

Bluetooth On/Off

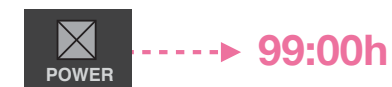
Power Save Mode On/Off

Quick settings should be repeated in the main settings list to allow for sub-setting modifications:
ie. visualizing available WiFi networks, or Bluetooth devices.

- 2 Tapping on a Quick Setting toggles between ON and OFF. The icon of each setting must change to signal the current status of that setting.

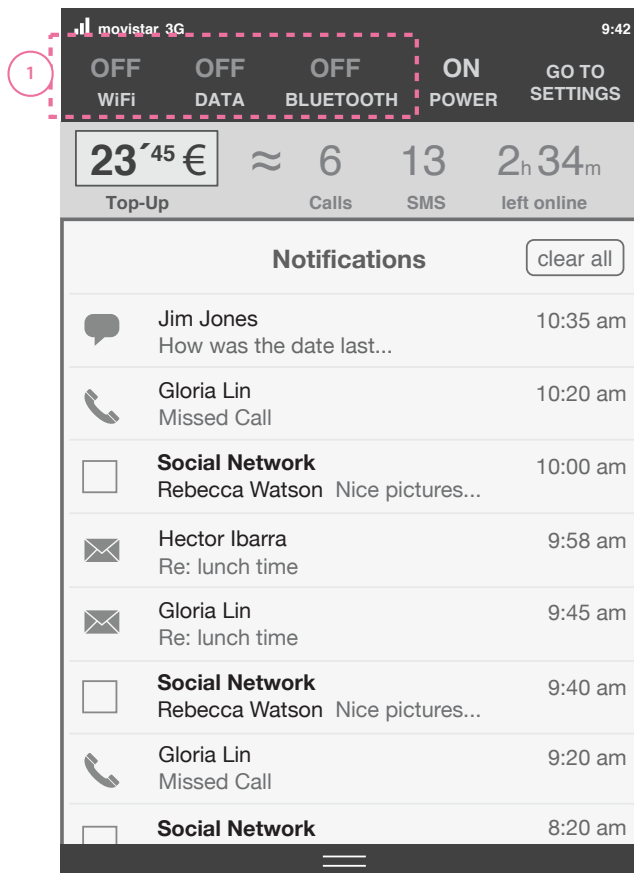
Power Save Battery Time

- 1 This button should also be an indication of the approximate time remaining on the battery. Clicking on Power Save should be reflected in an extension of the approximate battery time left.



Power Save Mode would automatically turn off WiFi, Data and GPS to reduce the amount of Battery consumption.

Power Save Quick Settings



Power Save Mode

Power save mode turns multiple settings off simultaneously to extend the life of the battery:

Data OFF

WiFi OFF

Bluetooth OFF

GPS OFF

(also dims screen brightness)

1 When a user turns mode ON...

All the above settings automatically move to the OFF position and are greyed out.

When a user turns mode OFF...

All above settings except Bluetooth and Data switch to the ON position.

When Power Save Mode is ON and other setting is turned ON...

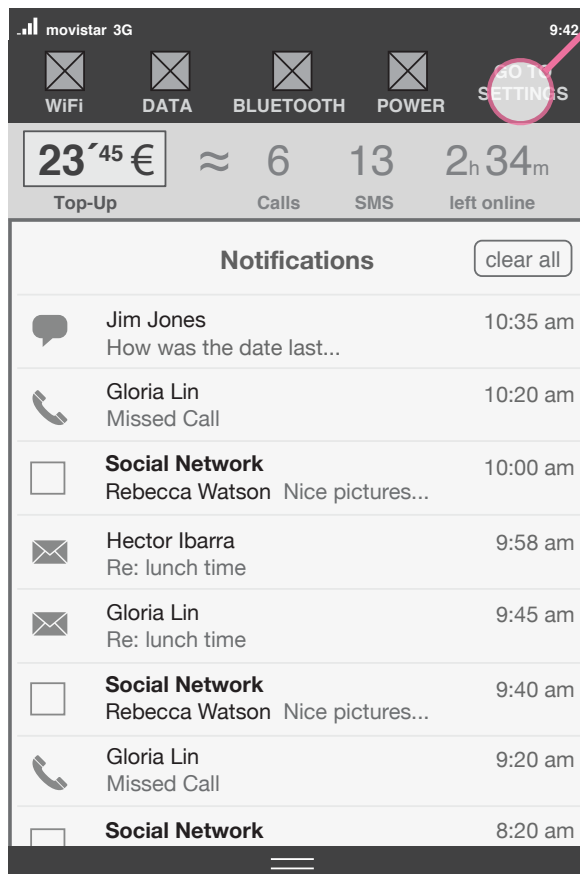
Power save mode is turned OFF.

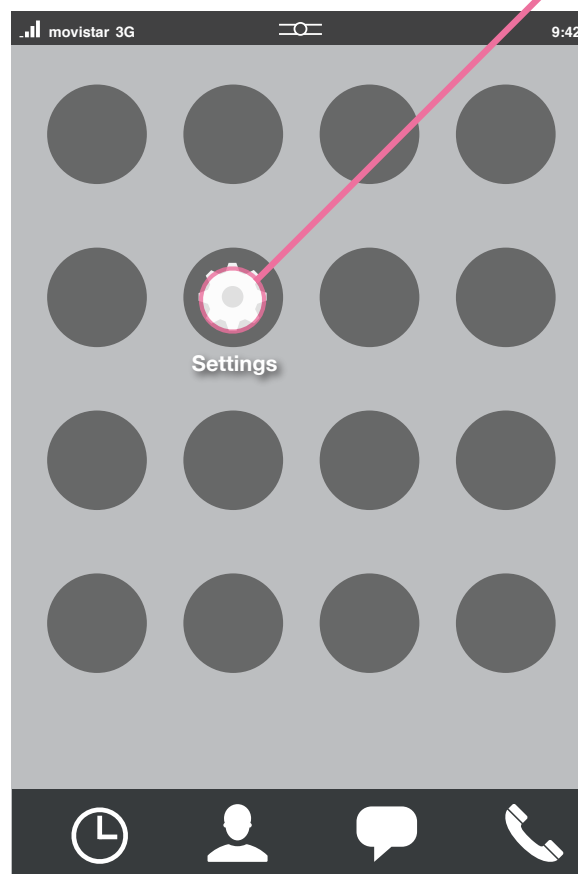

Settings Access

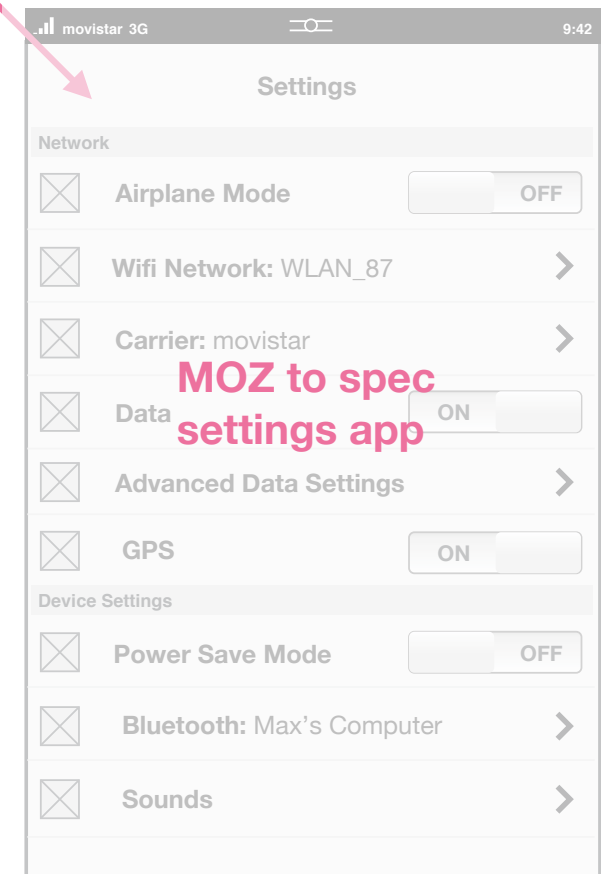
Accessed both from the Quick Settings area above the Notification Center, and from an Settings App icon in the grid.



Settings app access in Quick Settings



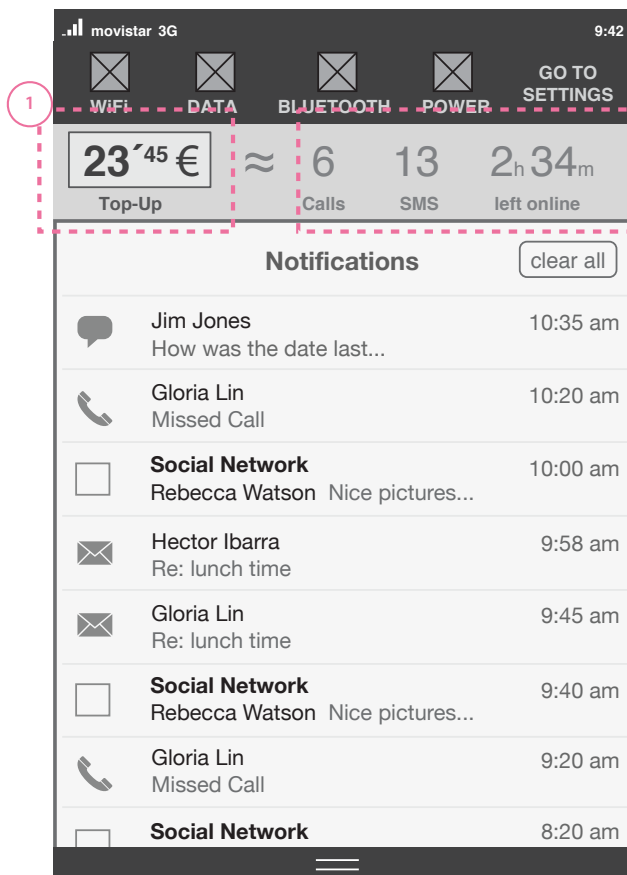
Settings in application grid

Credit Module Utility Tray

Under review by Telefonica on what can be done for V1/ V2.



1 Credit Status & Top-Up

Credit status should be updated in real-time to give user constant knowledge of pre-paid credit amount.

The credit status is a button that when pressed links the user to a free APN that allows them to purchase more credit.

2 Forecasting

Based on the available credit, the user's plan, and the usage patterns (average length of phone calls), the phone provides:

- the number of phone calls left
- the number of SMS left
- time available online
